BIENVILLE PARISH POLICE JURY HEAVY LOAD PERMIT REGULATIONS

1. A PERMIT DOES NOT SUPERSEDE POSTED WEIGHT LIMITS OR POSTED ROADS
2. NO PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN 60 DAYS, THE PERMIT CAN BE CANCELLED AT ANY TIME.
3. A COPY OF THE APPROVED PERMIT IS TO BE KEPT IN EACH VEHICLE THAT HAULS TO OR FROM THE PERMITTED JOB SITE.
4. RESPONSIBLE PARTY SHALL BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES CAUSED AS A RESULT OF WORK AUTHORIZED BY THIS PERMIT.
5. DISREGARD OF THE HEAVY LOAD ORDINANCE WILL RESULT IN FINES, FEES, PERMIT CANCELATIONS AND DENIAL OF FUTURE PERMITS
6. WORK MAY BE STOPPED IN WET WEATHER CONDITIONS.
7. THE POLICE JURY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DESIGNATE HAULING ROUTES PRIOR TO RECEIVING PERMIT.
8. IF THE WORK SITE IS IN AN ADJOINING PARISH, IT MUST BE WITHIN THE SURROUNDING SECTION OF THE BIENVILLE PARISH LINE IN ORDER TO USE OUR PARISH ROADS. BIENVILLE PARISH DOES NOT RECEIVE ANY TAX MONEY ON TIMBER CUT OUTSIDE THE PARISH.
9. EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT BE LOADED OR UNLOADED FROM PARISH ROADWAYS.
10. IN NO INSTANCE SHOULD A PARISH ROAD BE MADE IMPASSABLE FOR THE PUBLIC.
11. NO PERSON SHALL DITCH, CUT OR CHANGE SHAPE OF ANY PARISH OWNED AND MAINTAINED ROAD.
12. ALL COMPANIES MUST OBTAIN A PARISH HAULING PERMIT BEFORE ANY WORK IS DONE OR YOU WILL FACE PENALTIES.
13. THE PERMIT WILL BE AT NO COST UNLESS CAUGHT HAULING WITHOUT PERMIT, AND OR OTHER VIOLATIONS.
14. IF CAUGHT HAULING WITHOUT PERMIT YOU WILL BE CHARGED (500.00) DOLLARS FEE FOR THE NEXT PERMIT. NO EXCEPTIONS.
15. NO CONTRACTOR IS ALLOWED TO ALTER THE NATURAL DRAINAGE DITCH WITHOUT PROVIDING CULVERTS TO ALLOW WATER FLOW.

*No permit shall be issued for a permit longer than 60 days. The permit may be cancelled at any time.

*A copy of the approved permit is to be kept in each vehicle that exceeds the weight limit.

*Disregard of the Heavy Load Ordinance may result in fines, permit can cancellation or denial of future requests.

*Parish Roads are also governed by a Wet Weather Ordinance. Work may be stopped in wet weather.

*The Police Jury reserves the right to designate hauling routes.

*The Permit Applicant is responsible for informing the Police Jury if work is completed prior to the ending
